Dear Dealer,

Conjecture 2010 is now accepting applications for sales space in our Dealers' Room. The dates are set for October 1-3, 2010. We will be at the Town and Country on Hotel Circle in San Diego.

Conjecture 2010 will focus on Cyberpunk this year but will also have programming on a variety of science fiction, fantasy, and general fannish topics. Our Author Guest of Honor is Hugo and Nebula Award winning author Robert J. Sawyer. He's currently best known as the author of *FlashForward*, the basis for the recent TV show. Although we recently took a break, we're back and plan to be better than ever!

Tables are \$60 each and include one membership per table. Since table space is limited, we are initially restricting tables to two per dealer. Additional memberships are available at \$25 each. Space is allocated on a first come, first served basis. By convention time we often have a waiting list of dealers hoping someone else will cancel.

A few words about California State Sales Tax laws: If you don't have a Seller's Permit, and either you aren't selling Exempt Property or your sales aren't exempt Occasional Sales, then you must fill out a Temporary Seller's Permit. After the convention, you may be required to file a Sales Tax Return with appropriate attached forms. DEALER EXHIBITION CONTRACT

1. There is no smoking or otherwise burning objects within the Dealers Room at any time.
2. All dealers shall have a signed copy of the Dealers Exhibition Contract on file with the Dealers Room Coordinator. No dealer will be allowed to sell merchandise at the convention facility without having a signed copy on file with the Dealers Room Coordinator.
3. Dealers may play audio devices at moderate volume. The Dealers Room Coordinator reserves the right to determine the definition of "moderate volume".
4. All dealers must claim their tables before 2pm on Friday, October 1, 2010. Tables which have not been claimed by that time may be resold at the sole discretion of the Dealers Room Coordinator. Tables which are canceled without twenty-four hours notice may be resold at the sole discretion of the Dealers Room Coordinator. The rental price of tables which are either (a) unclaimed or (b) canceled may be refunded only if such tables can be resold by the Dealers Room Coordinator. Dealer agrees to hold the convention and Dealers Room Coordinator harmless for any lost investments or revenues as a result of either (a) unclaimed or (b) canceled tables.
5. All dealers certify that they have complied with all Federal, State, and local policies regarding the collection of any required sales taxes.
6. All dealers certify that they have complied with all Federal, State, and local policies regarding obtaining valid licenses required to participate as a dealer. Specifically, if you are doing business in San Diego six or more days per year, you will probably need a Business Tax Certificate. If you require a California Seller's Permit, information and an application may be obtained from <http://www.boe.ca.gov/sutax/faqseller.htm> . The same application form is used for temporary permits.
7. All dealers will obey all Federal, State, and local laws and ordinances regarding the sale of material which, intentionally or unintentionally, infringes upon the trademarks or copyrights of another party. Any dealer selling material which infringes on upon the trademarks or copyrights of another party shall be ejected without warning, and without refund.
8. Dealers shall not sell material which is deemed offensive or inappropriate. The Dealers Room Coordinator has the sole right to determine what is or is not deemed offensive or inappropriate. Dealers who continue to sell material which is deemed offensive or inappropriate shall be ejected without warning, and without refund.
